

ATTENTION SPORTSMAN!!

Since completion of the NYS budget, word of Conservation License fee increases, new license types, and age requirements has slowly spread and inquiries have steadily increased. Below is a list of the license types with the current and the new fees, as well as the age requirement changes that will occur in August 2009. Go to www.dec.state.ny.us/ for complete details. The new NYSDEC Conservation Licenses go on sale Monday August 17, 2009 for the 2009-2010 Season.

Lifetime Licenses may be purchased under the current rules and prices through September 30, 2009. David Shenk, Boston Town Clerk said "If you ever considered a Lifetime License NOW is the time to purchase it."

Some of the changes include: The senior age has increased from age 65 up to age 70, Deer Management Permits will cost \$10 for hunters age 16+ unless you have a Lifetime Sportsman purchased through 9/30/09 and Junior Hunt will now include Big & Small Game. NEW Licenses include Marine Fish, which is required for salt water fishing and Trapper Super Sportsman is also available.

Shenk stated, "Seniors, who are currently age 65-69 should seriously consider purchasing a Senior Lifetime Sportsman License for \$50, which includes Sportsman, Deer Management Permit Application and Turkey Permit for life. Senior fisherman would see a substantial savings as well."
