## **HUNTING LICENSES TO GO ON SALE IN BOSTON**

Town Clerk Jennifer A. Mulé announces that NYS Sporting Licenses go on sale **Monday**, **August 10**, **2015** at the Boston Town Hall. You may apply for a Deer Management Permit when you purchase your license. The Deer Management Permit deadline is October 1, 2015. Landowners of over 50 acres may apply with landowner status for their Deer Management Permit. You MUST provide the Swiss Code and Section, Block and Lot number of your property when applying. These numbers can be found on your property tax bill. Be sure to bring proof of residency. A Driver's License is preferred.

You may also purchase your license via the internet at <a href="www.dec.ny.gov">www.dec.ny.gov</a> look for the "Purchase a Sporting License Here" link under Hunting.

For Hunting and Trapping Licenses, the license year runs from September 1 – August 31. Annual Fishing Licenses and Recreational Marine Fishing Registration are valid for 365 days from date of purchase.

Active Duty Military Personnel stationed outside New York State and home on leave for (30) days or less are eligible for free Fishing, Big and Small Game and Trapping License.

Lifetime License Holders should receive their annual tags prior to September 1, 2015. You may also purchase your lifetime license at the Town Clerk's Office.
