

Town Board Minutes May 17, 2006

Present: Councilmen Brien M. Hopkins, Richard K. Hawkins, Dennis J. Mead, Councilwoman Cathleen M. Dobson and Supervisor William A. Eagan.

A motion was made by Supervisor Eagan and seconded by Councilwoman Dobson to approve the appointment, on the recommendation of Fire Chief Pluta, of Natasha Hawkins to the position of Patchin Fire Police, term to expire upon retirement, resignation or removal.
